

« 1 mètre de silence » est le multiple n.22.

Le multiple « 1 mètre de silence », réalisé en 2017, en édition limitée à 500 exemplaires seulement, est composé par 1 mètre de câble coaxial à gaine blanche, suspendu au mur.

« 1 mètre de silence » examine un outil de communication en sommeil, le câble coaxial, symbolisant la structure des sociétés riches en médias.

Utilisant des techniques minimalistes et inspirées de Duchamp, l'œuvre contemple l'organisation sociétale des médias et de la consommation. La sculpture représente un modèle spatial d'un non-événement acoustique, manifestant une contradiction dans son titre. Elle crée un sentiment d'attente tout en refusant l'accès à un contenu potentiel.

Cette pièce met également en lumière la transformation paradoxale d'un matériau de communication en obstacle, remettant en question si l'accumulation d'informations dans les sociétés médiatiques ne conduit pas à leur disparition, favorisant l'incompréhension, l'échec de la communication et la surdité due à un bruit accablant."

"1 meter of silence" is the multiple n.22.

The multiple "1 meter of silence", created in 2017 and limited to only 500 editions, is made with 1 meter of white coaxial cable hanging on the wall.

"1 meter of silence" examines a dormant communications tool, the coaxial cable, symbolizing the structure of mediarich societies.

Using minimalistic and Duchamp-inspired techniques, the artwork contemplates the societal organization of media and consumption. The sculpture represents a spatial model of an acoustic non-event, manifesting a paradox in its title. It creates a sense of expectancy while denying access to potential content.

This piece also highlights the transformation of a communications material into a barrier, questioning whether the information accumulation in media societies leads to its disappearance, fostering incomprehension, communication failure, and deafness due to overwhelming noise.
